

More milk, better milk

In three years of Silcock feeding and rationing, Mrs. D. M. Jeffery has raised the yields of the Friesians at West Street Farm, Seavington, Ilminster, from 1,151 gallons at 3.51% butterfat, to last year's average of 1,293 gallons at 3.67%.

Outstanding among this year's yields is that of the cow Dodington Fanny, which in 165 days has given 1,259 gallons, and is still giving 70lb. per day.
